

Baltimore Childhood Supply List

A kit for Baltimore Childhood is available for pre-purchase for a fee of \$25. Please order by August 1, 2014.

The kit includes background fabric, floral fabric for frame, and center toile fabric.

If you choose to use your own fabrics you will need:

24" x 24" square for background

19" x 19" square floral fabric for frame

12" x 12" square toile for center of block centered on a specific motif

Other supplies you will need for class are as follows:

Baltimore Childhood papercut pattern (supplied in class)

Threads to match fabrics

Freezer paper

Pencil

Permanent, acid-free marking pens, one light and one dark

Fabric and paper scissors with fine, sharp points

Appliqué pins

Appliqué needles

Stapler and staple puller

Iron and padded mat (one iron will be available to share in class)

Task lighting of your choice if needed

I will bring a cutting mat, rotary cutter and ruler to share in class for cutting blocks.

Broderie Perse Baltimore Garden Supply List

A kit for this class is available for pre-order for a fee of \$25 by August 1, 2014. The kit includes background fabric, floral fabric for the broderie perse, a green batik and a green print for making stems and leaves.

If you chose to use your own fabrics you will need:

18" x 18" square of background fabric
1/2 yard floral fabric for broderie perse
1 fat quarter green print
1 fat quarter green batik

You will need to buy fat quarters or half yard lengths of the green fabrics. 1/4 yard substituted for a fat quarter will not work for making the bias stems.

Other supplies you will need for class are as follows:

Book: "Baltimore Garden Quilt" by Barbara Burnham
Clover 1/4" bias tape maker
Roxanne's Glue Baste-It
Thread to match fabrics (Be sure to include an off-white or neutral thread.)
Appliqué needles
Paper scissors
Fabric scissors
Acid free permanent marking pens for light and dark fabrics
Pencil
Freezer paper
Light box
Padded design board
Appliqué pins
Regular sewing pins
Iron (one available in class to share)
Task light of your choice if needed
You may want to bring an extension cord for your light and iron.
A cutting mat, rotary cutter, and ruler (one of each available in class to share)
